What is the congregation's or organization's vision for ministry:

The Six Great Ends of the Church, described in Scripture and defined in the Book of Order, inform First Presbyterian Church's vision for ministry.

Our congregation seeks to live this purpose through preaching the Gospel of salvation to the world during weekly divine worship seeking the truth of Holy Scripture and guided by the Holy Spirit. We welcome and invite all people to join us in worship. The message of salvation is proclaimed and the Kingdom of Heaven is exhibited by the nurture and spiritual fellowship of our members and educational opportunities for all ages (Bible studies, Sunday School, Youth Group, Youth participation in worship, Book Club, Holy Communion to "shut-ins," Casserole Ministry to the ill, Partners-in-Prayer, monthly Family Table Gathering and alternative Sunday evening worship, yearly retreat). The message of salvation and exhibiting the Kingdom of Heaven to the world also extends into our community through our outreach programs: 1. Gibb's Pre-K and Sam Houston Elementary Schools (providing teaching supplies, teachers' lounge supplies, student reading program); 2. Huntsville Memorial Hospital (volunteers and snacks for the waiting rooms); homeless children in our community (hygiene items, clothing and school supplies, gift cards); 3. twice weekly Parents' Day Out program; 4. Thanksgiving Baskets for those in need; 5. Christmas Angels; 6. Meals-on-Wheels delivery; 7. Special Mission Projects.

How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

We want to build upon our congregation's strong culture of generosity, improve our current ministries, and encouragingly equip our members to share the Gospel with the community at large. We will use our limited active members to expand the work of the outreach committee for the most direct and effective benefit to our rapidly growing local community. We are broken humans in a broken world and are, therefore, prone to resist even positive changes. We will continue to appreciate who we are while encouraging and equipping our members to share the message of Jesus Christ in the community and to grow the Kingdom of Heaven here and now. We need a pastor who leads us through prayer, scriptural study, guiding of the Holy Spirit, and as a living example.

How will this position help you to reach your vision and mission goals:

First Presbyterian Church of Huntsville, Texas seeks to "Know Christ and to make Him known."

We are looking for a spiritually mature pastor who is continually learning and pursuing understanding of scripture while inspired by the Holy Spirit. This pastor will be adept at formulating and delivering scripturally based sermons proclaiming the full gospel of salvation from our sinful selves by the limitless grace of our loving God through His son, Jesus Christ. A compassionate and loving servant to all God's people will teach these qualities by showing concern and charity for the basic daily needs for "the least of these," demonstrating fellowship with the congregation, visiting members and shut-ins, encouraging the spiritual development of everyone in our congregation, and being involved in the local community of Huntsville, Texas. The pastor will help us consider thoughtfully the needs and fears of the congregation while honoring traditions with a fresh perspective and help us move forward in our ministry to this congregation and the community at large.

- Moderate Session meetings to provide for the life and ministry of the congregation.
- Be strong in administrative work, including supervision of one other full-time staff person and three part-time staff.
- Maintain regular office hours.
- Develop appropriate Staff support for programs for and committees of the congregation.
- Provide pastoral care of the congregation by welcoming confidential counseling and shut-in and hospital visitation.
- Officiate weddings and funerals.
- Represent FPC enthusiastically within the Huntsville community.
- Be prayerfully involved in the work of the Presbytery.
